



The Minutes of the CAB Monthly Meeting May 11, 2010

The meeting was called to order by the President, Scott Rowley, at 7:05 PM. There was a quorum present. The businesses in attendance were: Scott Design, Midway Country Lodging, Nurturing Tranquility and Spa, Hershop, Sacopee Valley Eye Care, Sebago Signworks, Cornish Historical Society, and Bangor Savings Bank.

The Secretary's Report was accepted as emailed.

The Treasurer's Report was read and accepted. The balance from April was \$7,745.08 with added interest of \$.68. Deposits of 8 memberships totaled \$480.00, 32 Spring Fling Tickets of \$480.00, Spring Fling Cash Bar Donation of \$50.00 and Spring Fling Auction Proceeds of \$749. Expenses included the Sacopee Valley House of Pizza Spring Fling meals of \$480.00, Spring Fling Printing to Scott design of \$38.29, Spring Fling Newspaper ad to YWSG of \$156.00 and Spring Fling Music to Peter Finkle of \$150.00. The present balance is \$8,572.59.

- I. Area business news- It was reported that the Full Circle Artisan's Gallery has opened.
- II. Web site- Adding a link to get back to the home page from every page has been added to the main navigation on the left. Scott is working on the Event Photos page and will create a link to it on the events page. We talked about putting the Cornish Historical Society Website link under the CAB Area Description on the Home Page. It was tabled to be discussed at next meeting
- III. Brochures - The brochures will be finalized and sent out for final review by the end of the week. The 2000 brochures will be distributed in Kittery and Fryeburg Visitors Center as they were last and CAB members will also be able to have a supply for their businesses.
- IV. Apple Festival- Scott and Patty have already started receiving calls about reservations for the Apple Festival. They will start the update of forms and PR.
- V. Bathrooms- We do not know if Mike Harmon will be able to clean the bathrooms this year or not. Teresa will check with Norman MacIntyre and see if he knows.
- VI. Spring Fling – Kimberlee Henderson debriefed the Spring Fling and after monies were collected and expenses were paid that CAB profited \$455.21. As agreed, this will be donated to the town for Pike Hall renovations. Thanks to everyone that helped and participated in the event.



VII. Current Business

- A. Bangor Bank Business Showcase- This is tomorrow night, May 12th and all businesses are welcome to participate and public is welcome.
- B. Scott will send an email to update everyone about the Sidewalk Painting for May 16th if it is still on.
- C. Scott talked about better use of the Thompson Park Kiosk such as Large Printout of the Brochure Map along with the listing of the CAB members and also posting of events in the area. Will check with the Town for permission. Banners- In May the process to replace the banners in town will begin.
- D. A vote was approved to place the Lilac festival for June 5th on the CAB events website.
- E. Cornish Summer Bandstand Series- CAB voted to sponsor the event again this year with a \$150.00 sponsorship.
