I thank all of you who have donated your time last year and I look forward to continuing the same strong efforts and will strive to make your ideas towards bringing change and improvements within the organization. CAB board of directors and myself welcome and encourage any suggestions that you can contribute this year. Sharing your input, volunteering your time, and your membership is important and necessary for CAB's continued success.

CAB continues with positive momentum by marketing and promoting interest and growth in Cornish and the surrounding area businesses. CAB members continue to include and give more to the communities each year. With the continuing efforts of the Cab Officers, the Board of Directors and the Business Members to promoting interest towards the Cornish area as a goal is illustrated by the following 2010 accomplishments:

- Keeping www.cornish-maine.org current creating over 47,000 unique visits, attracted over 40 emails sent from the Web site requesting information about Cornish and the surrounding area.
- Spring Fling profits of over \$900.00 donated towards the local food bank
- Started the CAB Membership Committee and CAB Community Committee
- Provided several local advertising opportunities to CAB members
- Researched advertising in Down East, Maine, and Yankee magazines for offering possible co-op advertising discounts to members
- Renewed our membership with Maine Tourism Association
- Updated the Cornish Brochure and distributed over 1,500 at Kittery & Fryeburg Visitor Centers and provided to local CAB member businesses to have in their shops
- Updated CAB member location map on the Thompson Park Kiosk.
- 2,000 Apple Festival flyers with current CAB member listing were sent to vendors, placed at stores in the surrounding towns, and at Kittery and Fryeburg visitor centers.
- Apple Festival attendance increased again and continues to be a whole community event.
- Increased the time for free carriage rides during the Christmas in Cornish event. 2 hours from Thompson Park and 2 hours at the Cornish Fair Grounds helping to expand this event for the whole town
- Continue to welcome businesses from surrounding towns allowing for CAB to market the Sacopee Valley area

CAB is well known as the sponsor of the Cornish Apple Festival every year at the end of September. This is our biggest annual fund-raising activity and certainly the most fun. The "Spring Celebration" continues as an annual event thanks to the support of CAB members. Of course, we do much more than fundraising. For example, every year we recognize a senior student at Sacopee Valley High School and award a scholarship and we have started to give back to the community and continue to sponsor the Christmas In Cornish weekend. In the past, many enjoyed The Strawberry Festival and CAB is looking to revitalize this event in 2012.
